District Attorney Announces Former Deputy Sheriff Sentenced in Child Abuse Case

December 3, 2018 TULSA, OK – Defendant Josh Randall Wood, a former Deputy with the Tulsa County Sheriff's Department, was sentenced to 25 years on three counts of Child Sexual Abuse – Child Under 12 in case CF-2017-2674.

Tulsa County District Judge William D. LaFortune sentenced Defendant Wood to a split sentence of 20 years in the Department of Corrections and five years on probation. The sentence came as a result of a plea agreement between the parties.

DA Kunzweiler stated, "In this case, we had a young child victim. A plea agreement in this instance certainly saved our taxpayers the expense of a trial, but I am mostly gratified that we were able to spare this child from the trauma of testifying to her experiences in front of a jury in open court."
