

# NEW DIRECTOR OF GENERAL FELONIES INSTALLED AT DA'S OFFICE

KEVIN KELLER BRINGS VARIED EXPERIENCE TO HIS NEW ROLE

Since instituting the “vertical prosecution model” at the DA’s Office, felony cases are now prosecuted by distinct specialty groups: Homicides, Crimes Against Children, Robberies, Special Victims Unit Cases, and Gang-Related Offenses. If a filed case does not fall all into one of these specialty areas, it is assigned to the General Felony Team, which is now under the direction of Assistant District Attorney, Kevin Keller. By far, the vast number of filed felonies in Tulsa County fall into this category, “totaling in the thousands,” says Keller. His team is comprised of eight attorneys.

When working on other teams in the DA’s Office, Keller says, “I reflected often on the general felony cases that were very disturbing to me, as a member of my community. My vision is for my team to effectively prosecute each case to a just resolution with public safety concerns at the forefront.” Keller’s team handles cases such as arson, shooting with intent to kill, assaults, trafficking, elder abuse, fraud and first degree burglaries, among many others.
